The group will be picked up by trolley and taken to the Historic District. The first Stop on the tour will be Marsha Thompson's Home that has been in the family for two generations. The Thompson home is located in the heart of Historic Savannah and boasts a beautiful upscale home and gardens.

The second stop will be at the Mercer House Museum. The Mercer House was designed by New York architect John S. Norris for General Hugh W. Mercer, great-grandfather of Johnny Mercer. Construction of the home began in 1860, was interrupted by the Civil War, and later completed circa 1868 by the new owner, John Wilder. The home was restored to its current beauty in 1969 by Jim Williams, one of Savannah's most dedicated private restorationists.

The third stop will be at the Duncan House. The Duncan House is one of a double townhouse built in 1869 for Daniel Thomas. The B.H. Levy's remodeled the townhome in 1897 in the Second Empire style and added the third story with a mansard roof. Virginia and John Duncan began their restoration in 1976 and the movie "Orphan Train" was partially filmed there in 1979.
